Ok, to be honest I only asked because you said you saw a bear with its cub on your last hike and I thought maybe we'd see them again, so I could record them and put them on Facebook or Instagram.

Paul

So you only came because you wanted something to post online?

Frank

Actually, yes.

Paul

C'mon man, I thought -

OVER THE SHOULDER SHOT

About 30 feet ahead a small bear is lying on the trail. It sees them but doesn't move. It seems to be hurt. Frank is trying to walk up to it with his phone out but Paul holds him back.

MEDIUM SHOT

Frank

What the hell man? I've got to get this on camera.

CLOSE UP

He is waving his phone in front of Paul's face who's rolling his eyes.

Paul

Are you crazy? You could get killed! We don't know if its mother is around. Would you really take the risk?

Frank

Ye.

Paul

Really? I mean if you have to take your damned video or photo or whatever, then do it from here. What we should do now is inform a park ranger.

Paul pulls out an old, bulky cell phone. Frank takes a few pictures oft he cub. While Paul is dialing, Frank sees his chance and runs off to the cub.

OVER THE SHOULDER SHOT

Paul (shouting)

Hey! What are you doing?

Frank

Don't worry Paul. I'm only going to take a selfie. I'll be back with you in a second.

MEDIUM CLOSE UP

He kneels down next to the cub and positions his phone. The cub starts to cry out but Frank is ignoring it.

Paul (0.S.)

Watch out!

Frank hears a loud noise from the trees to their side. He spins around and freezes.
